RESTAURANT MINIMUM

NO RESTAURANT MINIMUM FOR ANY MEMBERS

GUESTS

- A GUEST IS ANY NON-MEMBER, REGARDLESS OF RESIDENCY
- A GUEST MAY PLAY A MAXIMUM OF (10) ROUNDS PER YEAR
- THE HOST OF A GUEST MUST BE ON THE CLUB PREMISES WHILE A GUEST PLAYS THE COURSE
- ALL TYPES OF MEMBERSHIPS MAY HOST GUESTS

MEMBERSHIP TYPE UPGRADES (MID-YEAR)

- MAY BE MADE BY PAYMENT OF THE FULL DIFFERENTIAL BETWEEN MEMBERSHIP TYPES (NO PRORATION)
- PAYABLE UP FRONT

MEMBERSHIP TYPE DOWNGRADES (MID-YEAR)

- ALLOWED, BUT THE MEMBER MUST REMAIN AT THE LOWER LEVEL FOR AT LEAST ONE YEAR, OR PAY THE ACCUMULATED DUES DIFFERENTIAL BEFORE BEING ALLOWED TO MOVE TO A HIGHER LEVEL. THE ONLY LEVEL A MEMBER MAY MOVE DOWN TO (MID-YEAR) IS TO a SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP.

PARTICIPATION IN CLUB EVENTS

- CLUB EVENT ROUNDS COUNT TOWARDS ANY ROUNDS LIMITATIONS WHICH A PARTICULAR MEMBER HAS.
- "WEEKDAY ONLY" MEMBER TYPES MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN CLUB EVENTS HELD ON WEEKENDS (NOON FRI. THRU SUN), AND HOLIDAYS.
- SIGN-UPS FOR EVENTS WILL BE STAGED BY DATES, WITH VOTING MEMBERS HAVING FIRST PRIORITY.

MID-YEAR RESIGNATIONS

- NO REFUND OF DUES, EXCEPT BY BOARD APPROVAL

PAYMENT OF DUES

- DUES PAYMENTS WILL CONTINUE TO BE BILLED AND COLLECTED ON A MONTHLY BASIS.
- THE CLUB YEAR WILL BE FROM MARCH 1 UNTIL FEB. 28 OF THE FOLLOWING CALENDAR YEAR

MONITORING OF COURSE PLAY

- STARTERS WILL BE UTILIZED DURING PEAK USAGE PERIODS. THE STARTERS WILL RECEIVE PLAY TRADE-OFFS AS COMPENSATION. DURING NON-PEAK USAGE PERIODS, THE PRO SHOP WILL MONITOR AND CONTROL ACCESS TO THE COURSE.
- THE TIERED MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE WILL PREPARE A SPREADSHEET PROGRAM TO SUPPLEMENT THE EXISTING JONAS ACCOUNTING SYSTEM, WHICH WILL ASSIST IN MONITORING TIERED MEMBERSHIP USAGE.

GENERAL

- ALL MEMBERSHIP TYPES, AS WELL AS ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS, ARE SUBJECT TO REVIEW AND CHANGE BY THE BOARD AT ANY TIME.
